August 10, 2019 OPEN Livestock Show Rules

- 1) Open to participants of all ages. 4-H entrants must follow State guidelines for age.
- 2) There is a \$5.00 entry fee per species, payable to Richmond County Agricultural Fair. ***This fee is non-refundable.***
- 3) **All entries are due by July 15th.** If postmarked after July 15th entry will not be accepted. ***Space is limited. First come, first served!!***
- 4) **Entry forms must be filled-in completely. Incomplete forms may cause the entry to be voided and result in forfeiture of the entry fee.**
- 5) Mail completed entry form and payment to: Richmond County Fair Association OPEN Livestock Show, P.O. Box 152, Warsaw, VA 22572.
- 6) All animals must be checked-in and in place **by 10 a.m. August 10th**
- 7) ***All livestock must be free of disease and/or illness and will be inspected by a qualified livestock inspector BEFORE being allowed into the barn.***
- 8) ***All animals are to remain in the hauling vehicle until inspection is complete.***
- 9) **If your animal becomes sick during the Fair, you are responsible to have it removed from the Fair Grounds within one (1) hour of diagnosis.**
- 10) ***A "Certificate of Veterinary Inspection" declaring the animal is free from disease and/or illness is required.***
- 11) Ear Tags/Tattoos and Birth Dates are mandatory for all entries.
- 12) Cattle, Sheep and Goat Shows will take place Saturday, August 10th, at 12:00 p.m.
- 13) **No movement** of animals allowed during open Fair hours.
- 14) State Fair judging rules apply. **The decisions of the judges are final.**

RICHMOND COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION Agricultural Activities Waiver Form

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the agricultural activities at the Richmond County Fair Association, including the OPEN Livestock Shows, the Pee Wee Show, Goat, Sheep and/or Calf Shows, related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

RICHMOND COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION Agriculture Pavilion - General Rules

- 1) No solicitation of any kind, for any reason.
- 2) Wear appropriate clothing.
- 3) No open-toed shoes.
- 4) Park in designated areas only.
- 5) No alcoholic beverages or drugs.
- 6) No horse play, no foul language, or loud behavior.
- 7) Keep all aisles clear. Chairs, coolers, etc., are to be placed in designated areas only.
- 8) Any use of electrical equipment must be approved by the barn manager. This includes lights, fans, etc.
- 9) Displays must be made of decorations which are not harmful to the animal and/or cannot be ingested by the animal. Perishable items may not be used in the displays.
- 10) Keep pens neat and clean at all times. Bring buckets and a shovel. Dump buckets in designated areas only.
- 11) Keep feed in containers which are marked with your name and your animal's name and store in designated areas only.
- 12) If you use it, replace it. If you open it, close it. If you move it, put it back where you found it.
- 13) Only animals entered for exhibition are allowed in the barn area. Please leave your pets at home.
- 14) Do not handle or enter pens of animals other than your own.
- 15) Do not allow other exhibitors or the general public to enter any animal pens.
- 16) Animals are to remain in the Barn at the Fair Grounds for the duration of the Fair. They may not be picked up prior to Saturday at 8:00 p.m. Sunday pickup is available with prior permission.
